Rufous-collared Sparrow

One of the most widespread birds in the Americas, the rufous-collared sparrow is a common and familiar bird from Mexico to Tierra del Fuego, where it is as at home on city sidewalks as on wild woodland edges. This close relative of our white-throated and white-crowned sparrows has also occurred twice in the US, so be alert.
